

CPSC 351 — Information about Midterm Test

Time, Duration, and Location

The CPSC 351 midterm test will be written from 6:00pm until 7:30pm on Wednesday, May 27. This is an in-person test which will be written in SB 103.

Material Covered

The test will be based on material introduced in class concerning finite automata, regular expressions, and regular languages — that is, everything up to and including the lecture on Tuesday, May 19 (Lecture #5) and the tutorial ending on Thursday, May 21 or Monday, May 25 (Tutorial #5).

Recommended Aids — and Information about What is, and is not, Allowed

Students are asked to prepare a double-sided letter-sized page of notes ahead of time, which they can refer to while the test is being written. ***No other aids are allowed.***

The test must be completed by the student alone — consultation with others about the test material, during the test period, is academic misconduct.

Practice Test

A practice test, that is also based on the course material, is now available. Solutions for this practice test will also be available on D2L before the midterm test is written.

Absence from Test

Students who have registrar-scheduled lectures or tutorials that conflict with the time for this test will be given the chance to write this test at a different time, earlier on the day of the test — provided that they report this conflict on or before 11:59pm on Wednesday, May 20.
