Appropriate Uses of “Chat” With Messages to All

1. Answering a question *that the instructor has just asked — right now*.
2. Politely asking a question about, or politely commenting on, something *that the instructor has said or shown, right now*.
3. Politely answering another student’s *appropriate* question *when you are confident that you know the answer*.

Appropriate Uses of “Chat” with Messages to the Instructor

1. Asking about, or commenting on, something that *that the instructor has said or shown, right now* — when other students would not be interested or it might be embarrassing.

Appropriate Uses of “Chat” for Private Conversations between Students

- There are *no such things*.
