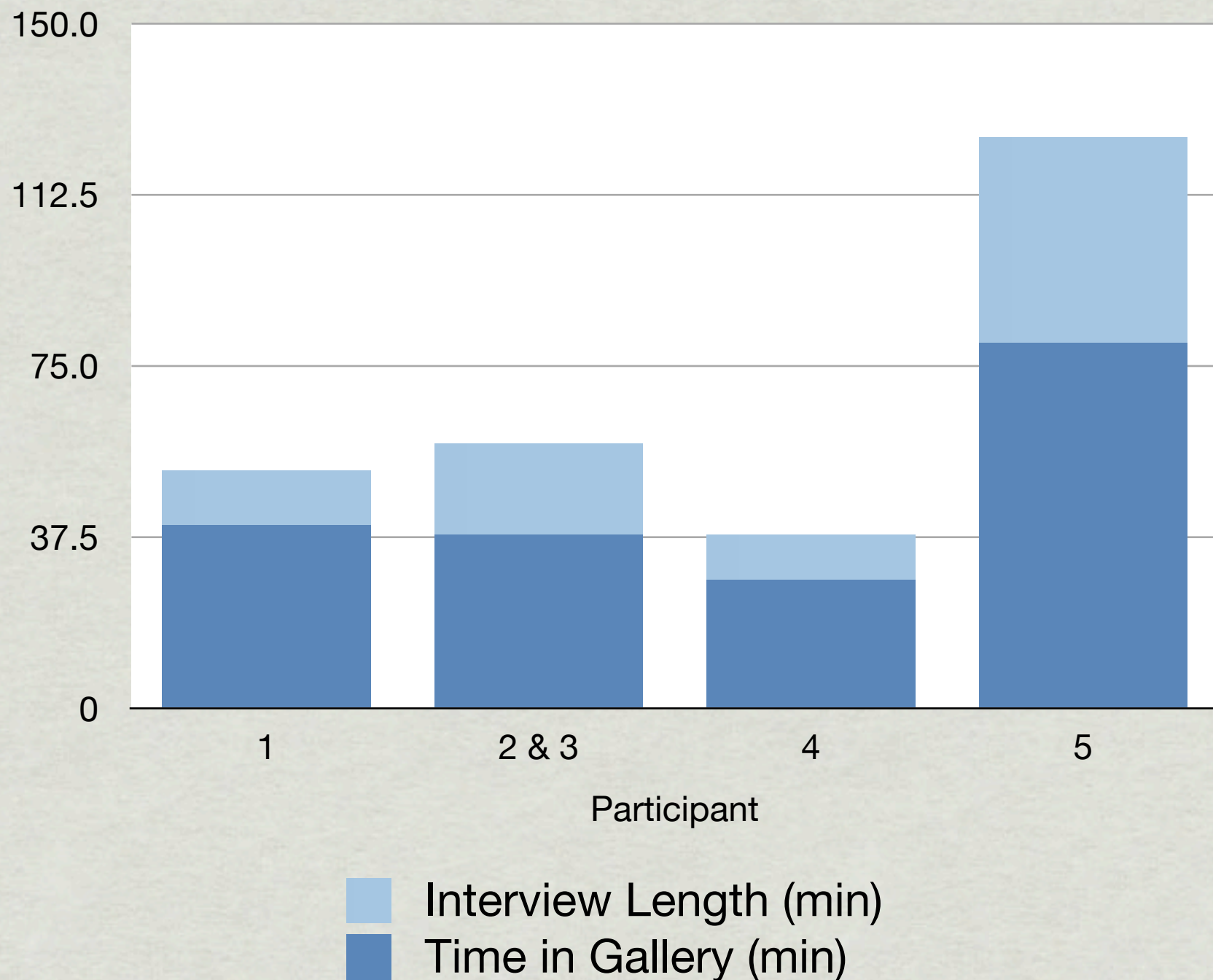

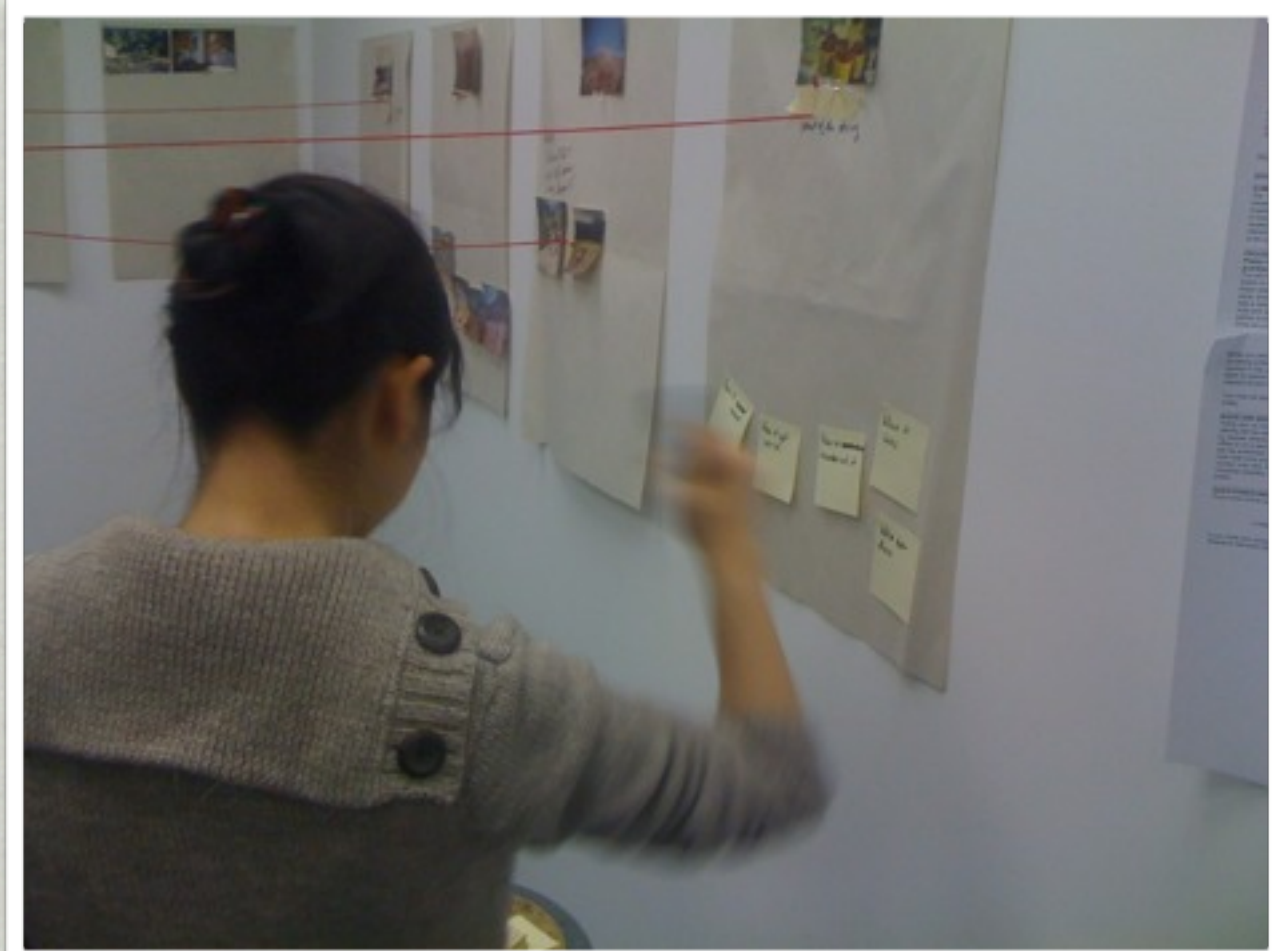
How do you feel about this being an anonymous collaboration?

How do you feel about this being an anonymous collaboration?

- 2: So this is a final art piece that is going to go under your name? I don't know how that would be.
- 3: There would have to be at least 30 [other] people, and then if it were in the National Gallery, I'd want my name on it, just to say that I had my name in the National Gallery, but not for any sort of notoriety as an artist. But if it were just two or three of us, and my name wasn't in it, I would be like "ohh." [Hurt/angry] That would change things.

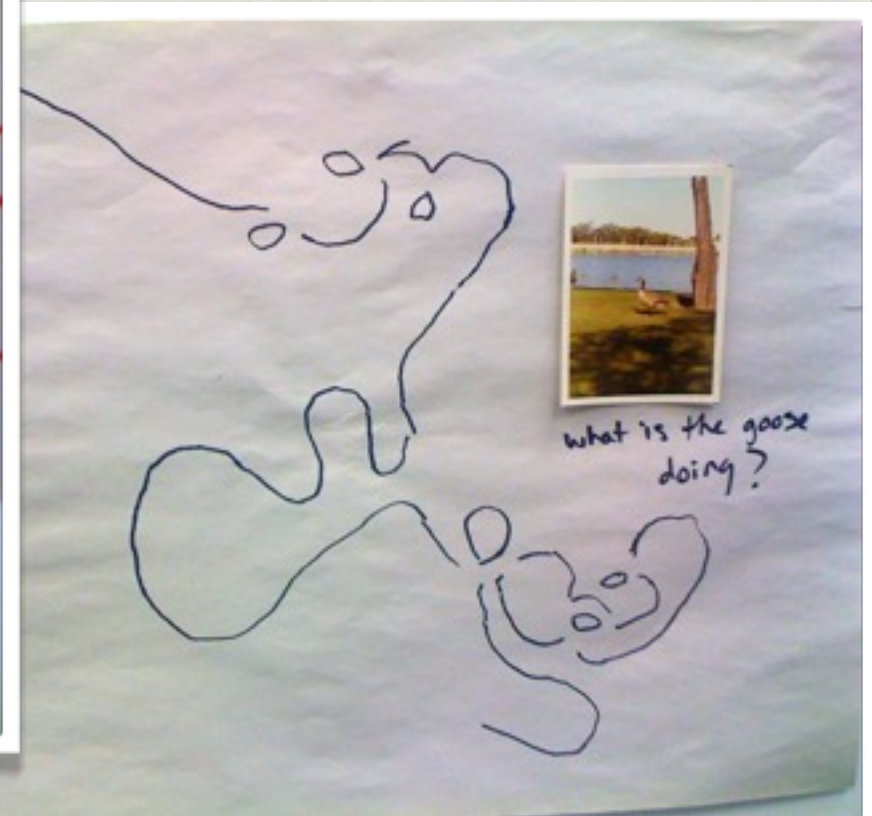
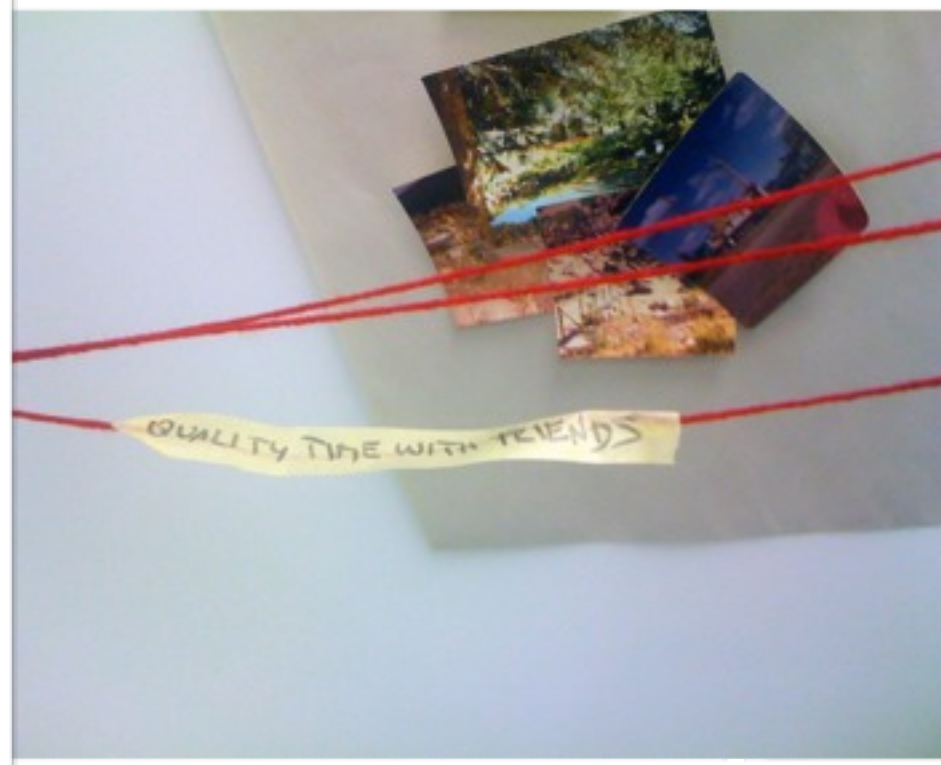
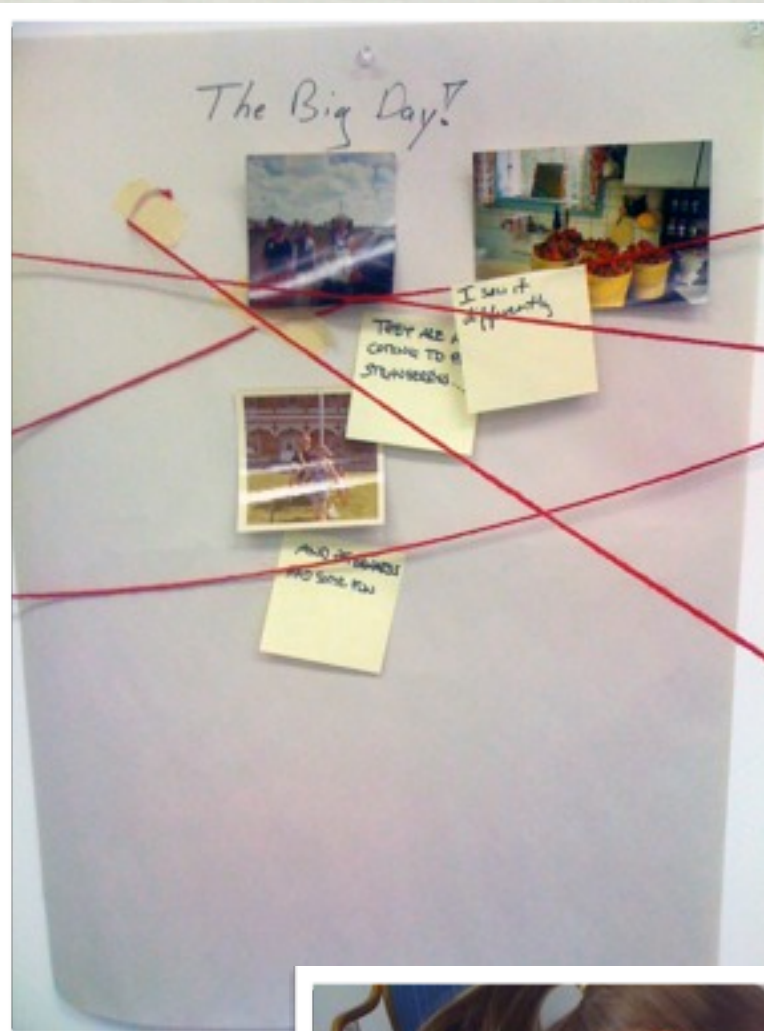

3: I would think that would be fancy-dancy artspeak.

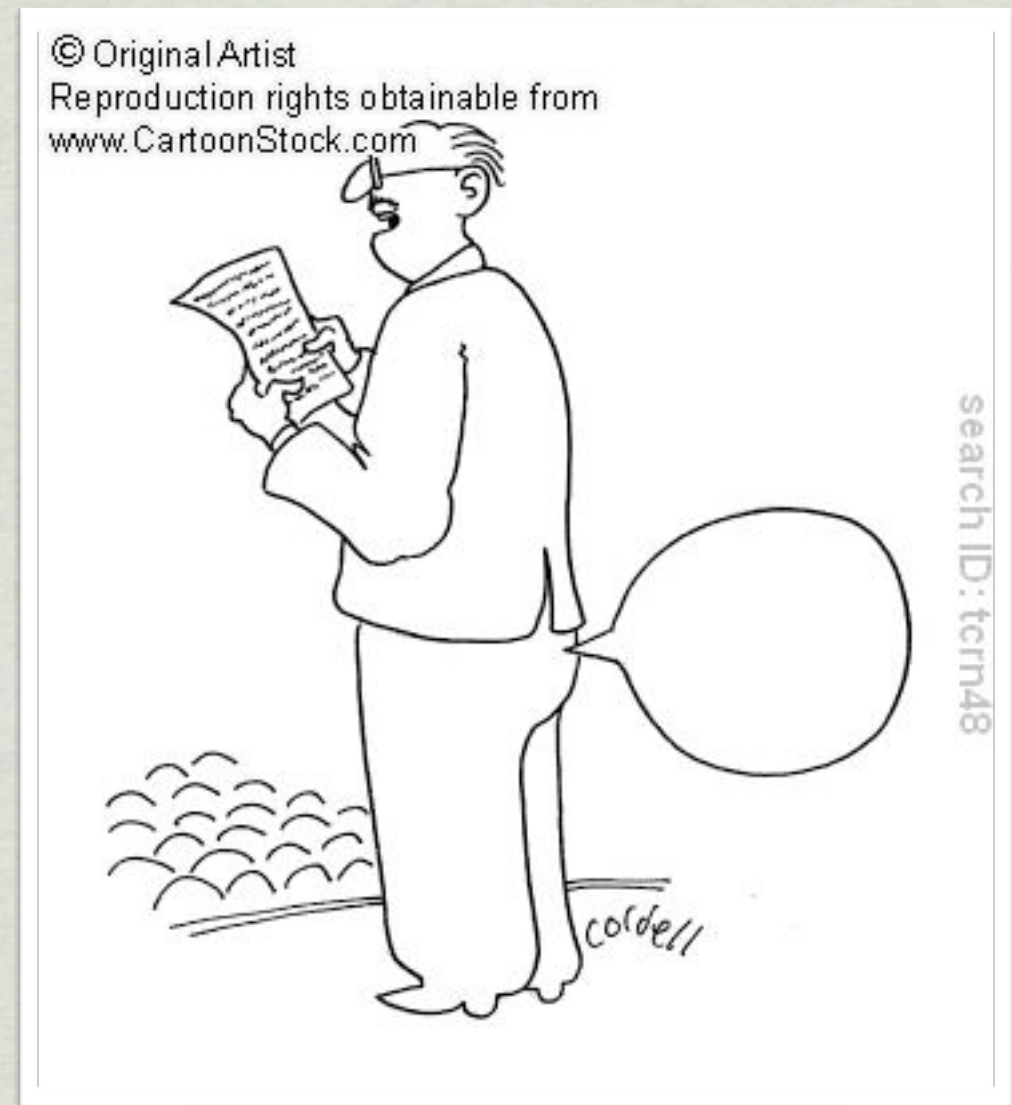


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Some problems with semi-structured interviews
