Short answer 3 (theory type question):

The following is a real life example that comes from the university calendar. Contrast the calendar description of the course prerequisites for CPSC 351 specified by the department of computer science vs. the version actually published in last year's university calendar.

Original calendar description:

3 units from Computer Science 219, 233 or 235; and 3 units from Mathematics 249, 265 or 275; and Philosophy 279 or 377; and Computer Science 251; or Statistics 213 and Mathematics 271 or 273.

Department prerequisite description:

3 units from Computer Science 219, 233 or 235; and Computer Science 251; and 3 units from Mathematics 249, 265 or 275; and Philosophy 279 or 377.

Department added note to prerequisites:

Computer Science 251 can be replaced by a combination of Statistics 213 and one of Mathematics 271 or 273.
